A Stop Work Order shall be issued and this Permit revoked if the Permittees are not in compliance with the DESC Permit, DESC Plan and/or GESC Manual, or the Permittees fail to take corrective action within the time specified on the written notification of such non-compliance; Understand that in addition to other remedies, a violation of this DESC Permit shall constitute a violation of the Stormwater Ordinance No. O-013-001 and Section 31 of the Zoning Resolution; and Understand any approval obtained from Douglas County does not obviate your need to comply with the requirements of the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Colorado Discharge Permit System, General Permit, and Sections 7 and 9 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, 16 U.S.C. 1531, <u>et seq.</u>, as amended, or with any other applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations.
