SUBJECT: **EVOC- TRAINING FACILITY, HELITAK AND DCSAR PROJECT**

SUMMARY

The Emergency Vehicle Operations Course (EVOC), located adjacent to 8500 Moore Rd in Littleton, CO, currently provides driver training for the Douglas County Sheriff's Office (DCSO) and other law enforcement agencies. Additionally, the site supports the Douglas County Helitak Program. At present, operations lack permanent supporting structures such as offices, training rooms, restrooms, and indoor storage, relying instead on portable buildings and restrooms.

To enhance the efficiency and future growth of these critical operations, we have developed conceptual plans for permanent supporting structures. Based on input from current users and in collaboration with Facilities, DCSO, the Office of Emergency Management (OEM), and Douglas County Search and Rescue (DCSAR).

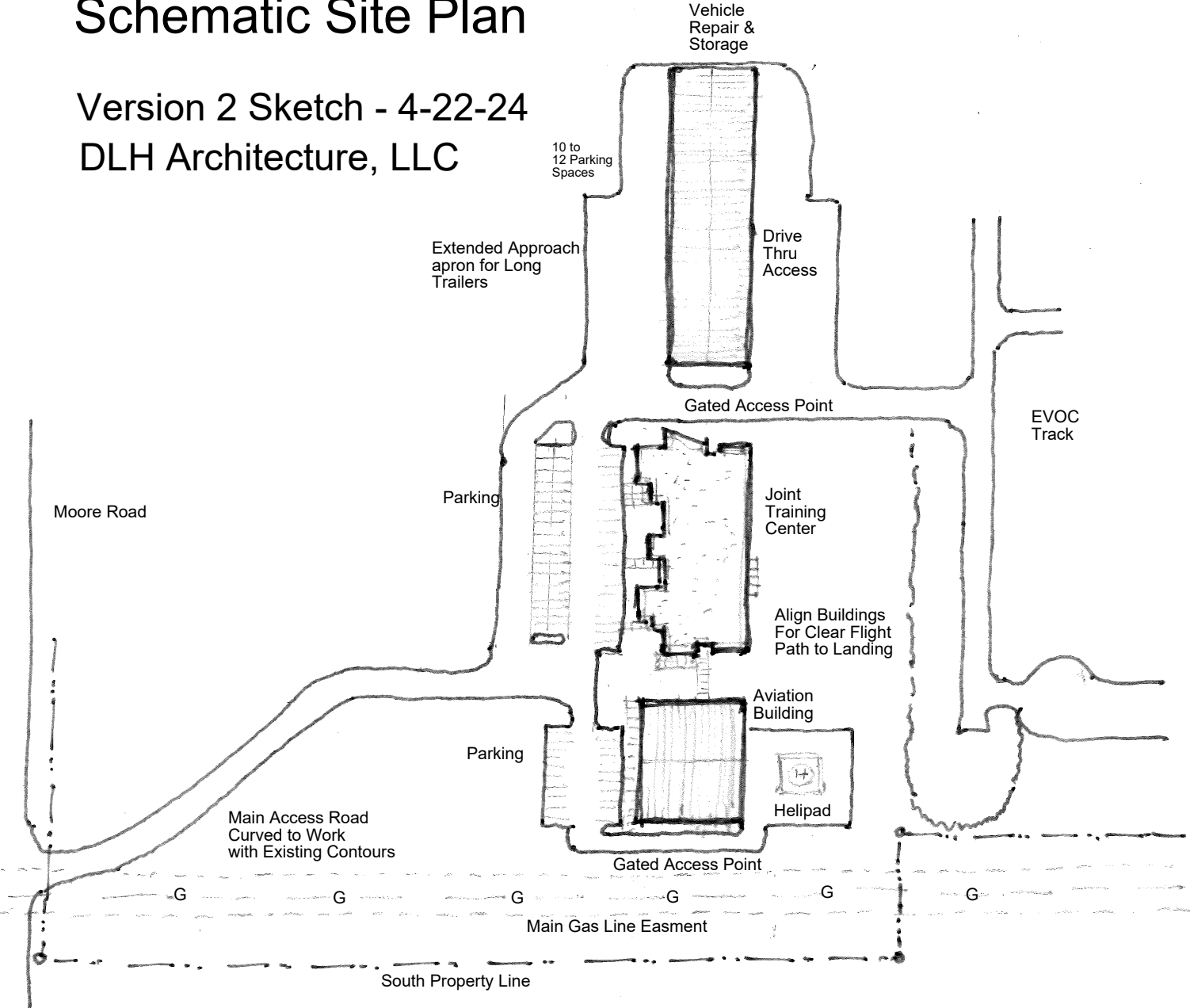
DISCUSSION

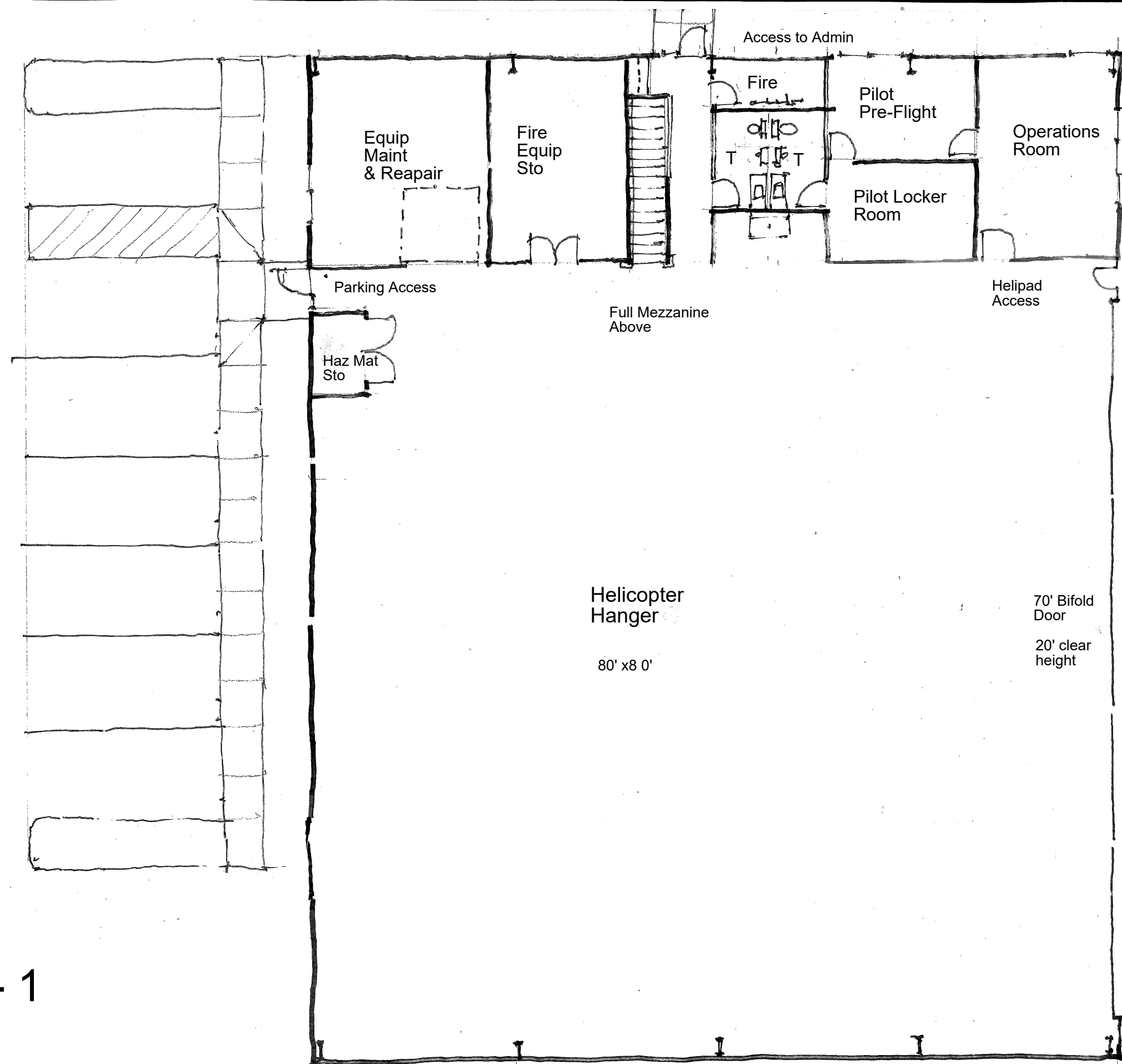
The estimated cost is \$14,700,000.00, excluding water, sewer, and electrical infrastructure, which will be determined during the contract and construction document phase.

To ensure the continued success of this essential facility, we seek approval to proceed with the development of contract and construction documents. Funding for this phase has been identified from the Justice Center Sales and Use Tax.

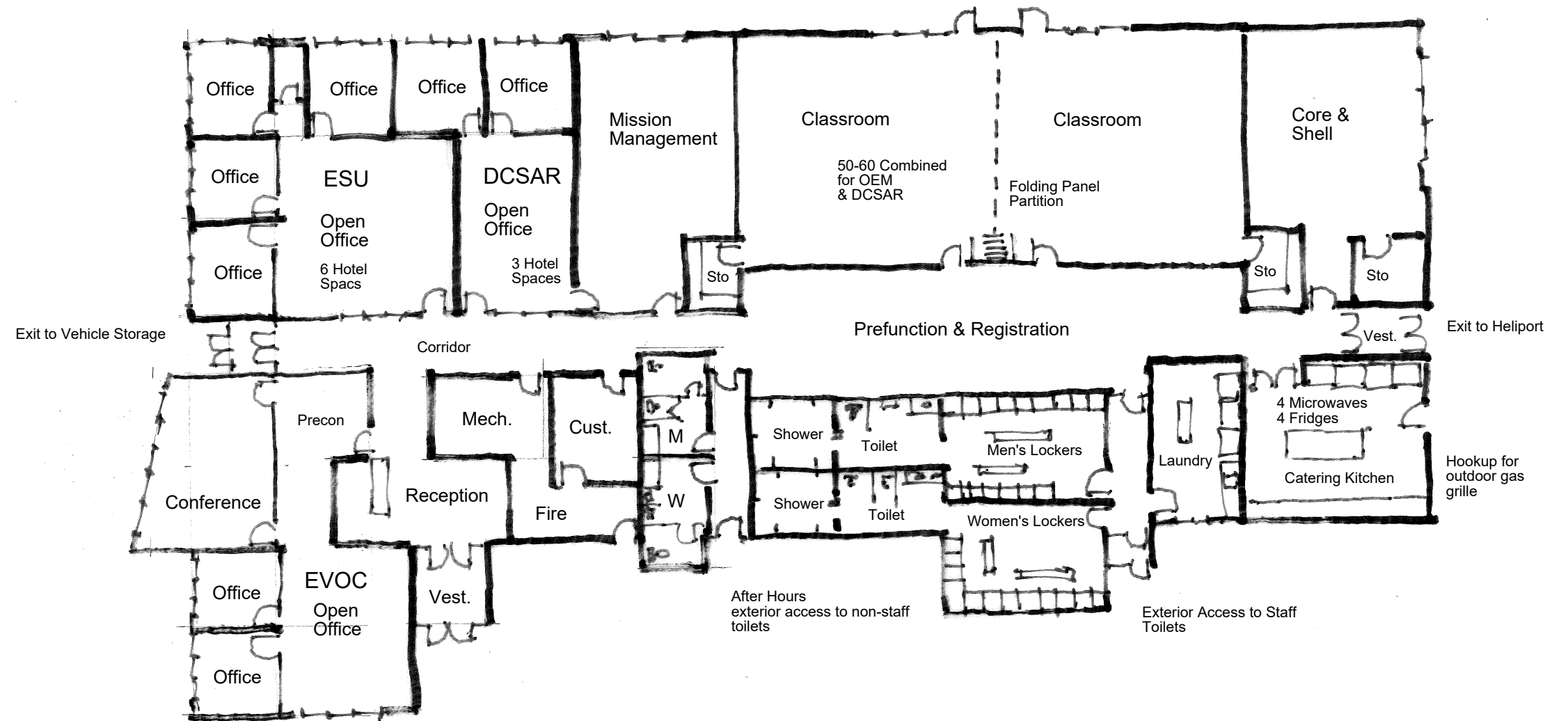


DCG - EVOC Site

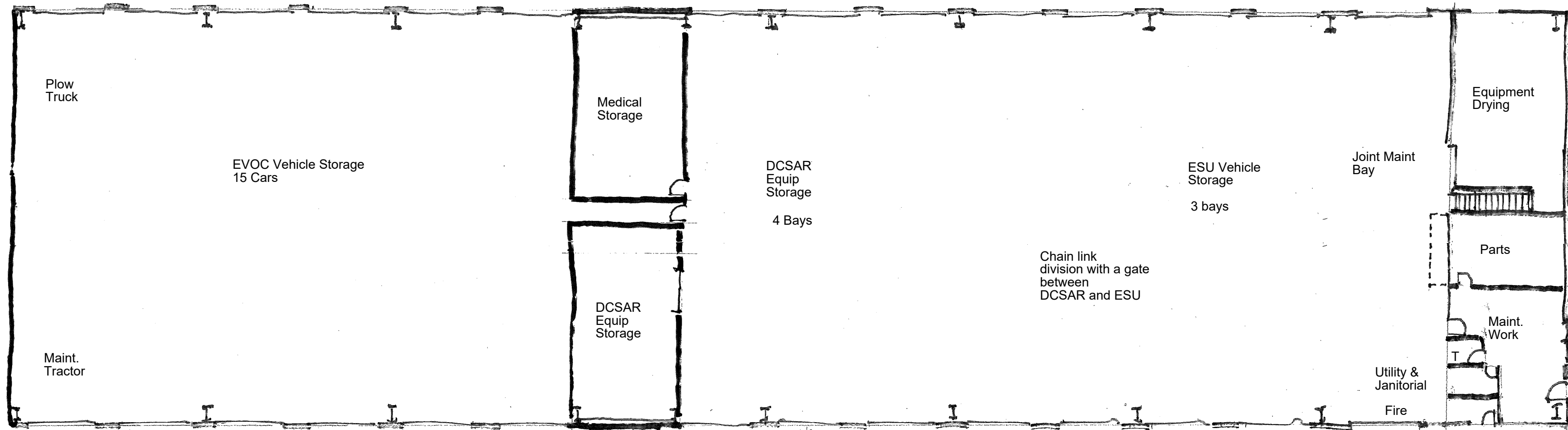
