

**JD 23 Timeline**

<b>Time Period</b>	<b>Event</b>
3Q/4Q 2018	District Attorney’s Office 2019 Budget Request Work Session.
December 2018	Judicial District topic discussed in a Legislative Strategy Session with Amy Atwood and Steve Balcerovich.
January 30, 2019	Stakeholder Meeting hosted by Representative Mike Weissman, at which objections were raised by Arapahoe County and State Judicial about costs and logistical impacts. Elbert and Lincoln Counties also expressed reservations. As a result, the draft bill was not introduced in the 2019 session.
February, 2019	Work session on February 5 <sup>th</sup> authorized a contract extension with Attwood Public Affairs that was subsequently executed on February 19 <sup>th</sup> . The contract was for strategic counsel and management of proactive legislation associated with the creation of a new Judicial District.
Throughout 2019	Stakeholder meetings to gain support for a 2020 legislative session bill. Updates as applicable Commissioner’s Admin meetings.
January, 2020	Douglas County entered into a contract with Attwood Public Affairs for ongoing professional services and assistance “regarding proactive legislation in 2020 associated with a bill that will create the new Colorado Judicial District 23.”
2020 Legislative Session	Bill introduced 1/8, passed House Judiciary 1/23, House Appropriations 2/4 and full House on 2/6. Passed Senate Judiciary 2/19, Senate Appropriations 2/25, and hull Senate 2/28. Updates in Legislative calls.
August 2021	Staff begins collaboration and planning with Arapahoe, Elbert, and Lincoln Counties and the District Attorney’s Office. Update to the Board in October.
January, 2022	Douglas County issues RFP for transition consulting on behalf of Arapahoe, Elbert, and Lincoln Counties and the District Attorney’s Office.
March, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• County enters into an IGA with Arapahoe, Elbert, and Lincoln Counties, and the DA’s office for transition planning.</li> <li>• Staff begins collaboration with George Brauchler at Board direction in an Admin meeting, continues through 9/22</li> <li>• CGL selected as consultant to counties.</li> </ul>
November 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Final CGL report issued and presented to Boards in all four counties.</li> </ul>
